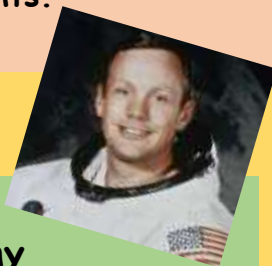


## History
