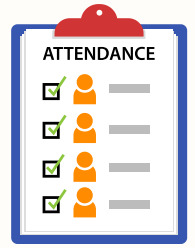

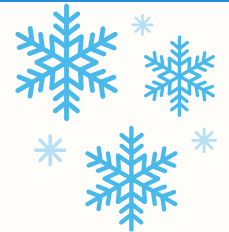

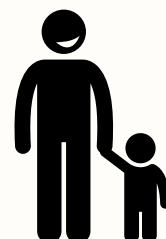
Should you require to collect your child early from school for an appointment could
