## RE: Year 1 and 2 PE Kits

Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this letter finds you well and that you and your family have had a restful and enjoyable summer break. As we prepare to welcome the children back for another exciting school year, I wanted to bring to your attention an important reminder regarding our Physical Education (PE) sessions.

## Physical Education (PE) days and Uniform Update September 2024.



We have made some adjustments regarding what children in year 1 and 2 should wear on PE days to maximise PE times.

Children in year 1 and 2 (Robins, Wrens, Swifts and Swallows) are now required to come to school dressed in their PE kits on days when they have PE. This change aims to reduce the time spent changing clothes, allowing for more efficient use of PE time.

Children in Reception (Chicks 1 and 2) will continue to get changed into their PE kits in school. This approach supports children's physical development and independence skills teaching children to work through the process of changing clothes.

Reception children are to bring their PE Kits into school every Monday and leave it on their peg until home time on a Friday. An adult will remind your child to bring their PE kit home each week.

## PE Kits:

- T Shirt-royal blue with or without logo or a plain white t shirt.
- Black shorts
- Black leggings or Black tracksuit bottoms.
- Royal blue school jumper or school fleece with or without logo.
- Trainers
